

April 25, 2015 - April 25, 2018: 3rd Anniversary of Marie-Paule's Death

April 25 will mark the third anniversary of Marie-Paule's death. That is why we have put together, in a sort of brief dossier, a few documents about this event, each one of which underlines a different aspect of Marie-Paule's life and work. First of all, there is, below, the homily delivered by Father Denis Thivierge in 2016, at the time of the first anniversary of Marie-Paule's death. Homage to Mother Paul-Marie

Dear Mother,

Since you have left us, your memory has remained very much alive in our hearts; you are even more present than ever in our lives.

It is only very late that we recognized you for who you are, so much so were you living simply and without affectation. You, a woman born like us in every way, you never compromised with evil. Having always corresponded to God's plan of love, you are a model in all things!

Every day, you climbed higher, prompted by an inexhaustible courage, and you overcame all the difficulties found along your path. Without ever looking back at what you had left behind, at what you had given up, you always went forward.

Having suffered "a thousand deaths", you nevertheless lived in a profound, unfailing joy. You experienced the bite of poverty, but you thanked the Lord for this. Having a delicate state of health, you put up with a very trying married life for many years and then suffered from your children having to live apart from you, but you never stopped giving thanks to our heavenly Mother.

You carried your very heavy cross with generosity and love, seeing God's action in every event, favorable or unfavorable, and collecting with gladness the precious fruit of your love which gave all, forgave all and abandoned itself in all things. "*Nothing for you, all for God and for souls*", there you have what sums up so well your life of Love!

You experienced sarcasm, contempt, rejection, but you always exulted with joy in the Lord. You thanked those who threw stones at you, declaring that "*they could not know the compensations God grants to the souls that suffer persecution for the divine Cause*." You asked God to forgive them just as you had already forgiven them.

Rejected by many, you were nonetheless always ready to receive with open arms anyone who requested help. You would hasten to come to the aid of those in need; suffering more than they were, you always knew how to soothe their little pains and communicate to them the desire to become better.

You never sought titles or honors, or your own interests or even the affection of your children or of the members of the

Work. You really liked the humble tasks such as peeling vegetables or doing laundry, for this allowed you to enter into contact with Heaven. You did not look for friendships or favors, and you shied away from all social life, finding your delight in living among the humble and lowly who are able to recognize God's language in the events that often go unnoticed.

You feared only two things: first of all, offending God through sin and not understanding well Heaven's messages and thus leading people into error. In fact, you had but one desire, that of pleasing God even if that meant, in the end, taking His Son's place on the cross. United with God, faithful to all the messages from Heaven, you saw to it that the Army of Mary would evade all the plots hatched by its enemies. With blows, abuse and insults heaped upon you, you celebrated a sort of continuous triumph, for the Word of God was being fulfilled. The cross sealed your mission and confirmed it.

By being near you, we realized how great God is and especially how good He is. Who are we for the Lord to turn His attention to us to the point of wanting to uplift us to Him? God has rendered us capable of being "divinized" if we accept to live off love, to let ourselves be purified, to let ourselves be transformed by divine Love.

And this, Marie-Paule, you have shown it to us better than anyone. Nothing could stop you in doing God's holy will. You knew that by deviating even by just one degree from the plan foreseen by the Father, everything could collapse. Your greatest torture would have been to lose God's Love.

You were never able to do what you would have liked to do, and you had to do what went against your will. But in all of that, you were still filled with gratitude: "*Lord, I would not have chosen for myself a life such as you have given me, but I thank you for having given it to me just as it is. I have no regrets. I have followed you along the way of suffering, and I have known true happiness, authentic love and a so-sweet peace. Thank you, my God!*" (*Life of Love III*, pp. 56-67)

This is such a simple piece of advice and yet so very important. It has been seventeen years that we have cherished it in our hearts. We promised ourselves that we would pass on this message, received from the very lips of Marie-Paule, to our own children when they would commit themselves to the married life.

Let us hope also that these words from Marie-Paule will be able to take root in the hearts of all the couples who wish to commit themselves to this wonderful vocation of marriage as well as in the hearts of all those who are already married. It is a maternal recommendation and a line of conduct which we must put into practice every day so as to make of our little lives, of our lives as a couple and our lives as a family other "lives of love".

Marie-Paule and her Mystery: A Revelation of 33 Years

The first volumes of *Life of Love*, Marie-Paule's spiritual autobiography, were published in French in 1979. As of that moment, all the readers of this work knew that Marie-Paule had been chosen by Heaven for a very special mission, for it was revealed in it that She was the "*Reincarnation*" of Mary. (vol. I, p. 334) Likewise, in 1980, the readers learned that Heaven had described Her as "*Co-Redemptrix*". (vol. XIII, p. 85)

In 1985 and 1986, the first books concerning her Mystery were published. In them, we discovered that there was a "*Trinity of the Immaculate*" of which Marie-Paule was the second person and that this Trinity was transformed, along with the Divine Trinity, into a new "*divine Reality*" in five Persons. We also learned that Marie-Paule was the "*feminine complement or counterpart*" of Jesus Christ, that She, like Him, had won the Eucharistic state and that She formed with Him the divine Redemptive Couple, in the image of the divine Creator Couple made up of the eternal Father and Mary the Divine.

A few years later, Heaven confirmed Marie-Paule's divinization when It said to Her: "*You are divinized*". (*Vie d'Amour*, Appendix V, p. 323) Then, in 2001, in the little book *Marie-Paule and Co-Redemption*, obvious facts were set before us, namely, that Marie-Paule was Christ as Woman next to Christ as Man, that She was co-eternal with Jesus Christ. That same year, Marie-Paule revealed, in the paper *Le Royaume*, the term "*Quinternity*" (no. 149, May-June 2001, p. 6) which would henceforth designate the "new Divinity" made up of "*the Father and the Mother, the Son and the Daughter, in the unity of the Spirit*".

In 2006, the manner in which Marie-Paule brought together in her the two natures, divine and human, after the example of Jesus Christ, was explained; and in 2007, Padre Jean-Pierre promulgated the dogma of "Marie-Paule Lady of All Peoples, Co-Redemptrix, Mediatrix and Advocate". Then, in May 2008 and 2009, She had to enter Spir-Maria dressed as "*Sovereign of the Earth*" and as Queen; and on May 31, 2009, She was canonized during her lifetime.

Finally, on May 31, 2010, she was declared "Mother of the Kingdom" and, on May 31, 2012, the process of the public revelation of her Mystery had reached its term. In fact, on that day, She was solemnly "presented and hailed" as being "God". The entire process of this revelation, from 1979 to 2012, had thus taken exactly 33 years. Similarly, 33 years had passed between her entry into the Divinity when She wrote: "*I am becoming light in the Light*" (vol. XV, p. 512), and the recognition of her own divine State. God really arranged everything.

It is out of gratitude to and love for Marie-Paule that I want to share with you a miracle She accomplished recently.

On Sunday evening, February 25, 2018, Joseph, my seventeen-year-old grandson, until then in perfect health, received the Sacrament of Extreme Unction just hours after he went to the emergency room for a rash. The doctors discovered that he had Type A flu, with an unidentified infectious virus. Joseph's body was already in a state of sepsis. Since the hospital did not have the facility to stabilize him, he had to be transported to Worcester's UMass trauma center.

On his arrival at the trauma center his body was swollen twice his size because of the unknown virus. The doctors were trying to keep ahead of the infection that was spreading through his body at a rapid pace. Joseph quickly began to lose his ability to breathe and his heart could not pump on its own to maintain his blood pressure. The doctors had no choice but to intubate Joseph, putting him under heavy sedation in order to stabilize him. Joseph was aware of his condition and his last words to all of us were, "I love you!", for machines were now keeping him alive.

The unknown virus, however, could not be restrained and began to attack his liver and kidneys. His fever was climbing over 103°F [39°C] and could not be controlled. As the hours passed more symptoms began to appear; fluid was filling his lungs, and a pleural effusion was evident. The medications administered were beginning to negatively affect his body. Joseph was dying; we just couldn't believe it...

On Tuesday morning I wanted to put Marie-Paule's picture on Joseph but the doctors were not letting anyone get near him. He was closely monitored because of all the machines that were attached to him. I went home discouraged. Tuesday evening I received an e-mail from a priest, Son of Mary, asking if anyone had


used Marie-Paule's picture on Joseph. This sparked my faith to try again the following day.

That night I prayed to God intensely, so that He would open the door for me to reach Joseph. I placed all my faith in Marie-Paule, asking Her to radiate Her love throughout Joseph's heart, soul and body, and for the Will of God to be done.

On Wednesday morning, I contacted my daughters, Jacinta and Christine, telling them I had to go and put Marie-Paule's picture on Joseph. Within an hour my family knew the reason why I was going to the hospital. Once again, however, when I arrived I could not get near Joseph. My daughters, son-in-law and I had to sit and wait. A nurse, who sat behind a curtain only four feet from Joseph, monitoring the machines, went by his side every few minutes making it impossible to get close to him.

At one of these intervals, when the nurse finished checking Joseph, as she was walking away from him to go behind the curtain, Christine said "Go!", pushing me to get up and go put the picture on him. I looked at Jacinta who said, "Yes, go." With courage and faith in Marie-Paule I went and put the picture on Joseph's forehead, which was the only area clear of any tubing or tape. I prayed to Marie-Paule quickly and I was able to squeeze in a few words to Joseph before the nurse came running in to remove me from him. This all happened in less than a minute.

Then everything began to change! By early the next morning Joseph began to over-breathe on the ventilator, a sign that he was beginning to breathe on his own! The doctors began to lower all medications of sedation. Then they were able to remove the breathing tube completely. Afterwards, Joseph's heart began to heal and became strong enough to pump on its own. The doctors completely weaned him off the medication for his heart, removing the intravenous that was in his neck. Shortly after that, they began decreasing all medications and removing

all five IV's on his body. His fever began to decrease.

Prior to that, the doctors were contemplating putting a chest tube in but they declared, "With all this sudden and unexpected change, let us wait." Joseph never needed the operation since the fluid that was being retained in his body began to disappear... All Joseph's medical conditions began to vanish, one by one.

Three days later, Joseph was transferred out of the Intensive Care Unit. He began to eat and drink small amounts, walk slowly, and move his fingers. The doctors could not understand... They threw up their arms and told my daughter that they did not know what to say. They told her, "According to his charts we should keep him in the hospital, but according to his health, he is ready to go home." Joseph went home three days later on Tuesday, March 6.

The same Son of Mary who suggested we use Marie-Paule's picture said to me and all my family during this trial, "Stay confident in God who is love." Yes, God is love and Marie-Paule is love, and Her Work is a Work of love!

Love was everywhere: the love of all those who prayed for Joseph, his love when he said to everyone, "I love you," before going into his coma, the love of Marie-Paule who is the very love of God. May this love radiate to every corner of the world, so that every soul may believe.
