We would not really need a text today to develop our topic. In fact, simply exposing pictures of Marie-Paule could be enough to present our message. Pictures of Marie-Paule in full action, during a discussion or immersed in prayer. Pictures representing her looking at us at times or seeming at times to be examining the universe through us, but always in an intense exchange which is like a communion of the mind, of beings who meet one another and who know all there is to know about the other person.

All those who have met Marie-Paule can testify to what they felt when they came in contact with her: a unique moment, a moment of great spiritual closeness, a privileged moment of communion between souls. Marie-Paule had that incomparable look in her eyes during any encounter or meeting, whether it was with one single person or with a large assembly. Without being able to explain it, everyone perceived, when he or she met her, that expression of authentic Love. With her entire being, Marie-Paule welcomed or received the other person without any barrier or prejudice, revealing in this way the openness of the Lady of All Peoples towards everyone.

This “expression of Love” is what will permit the transformation of the world to come. It is an appeal being made to men and women, the hope of a better world, like a gesture showing us the road to follow so that the new world can be established, this world which will be ours one day and that of our children.

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Many of us retain the memory of a meeting with Marie-Paule. This memory, as much as the words exchanged at times, still sustains us today as we go along our way. The writings Marie-Paule left us are essential and represent the foundation of her message which will travel down through the ages. But we, her contemporaries, were in contact with her, felt her eyes alight upon us, felt the expression of Love she passed on through the grace emanating from her person, and we are thus in a position to attest to the Lady’s call, a call projected by her entire being, that all the peoples

join her in the great transformation which is to lead to the world to come.

We need only recall how she would address a large assembly. Those who had an opportunity to see her during major ceremonies or on pilgrimages will remember the impression she left us at the end of her talks.

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All of us have much to learn from the writings Marie-Paule left us, but also much to learn from the person she was, from the expression in her eyes, from the energetic manner in which she moved about, from her smile, from the call emanating from her entire being in order to rally everyone to a common cause.

It is our duty to keep alive the memory of each of our meetings with Marie-Paule, whether it was individually or within a group. We are the living witnesses of those privileged moments. May we always remember the content of those “encounters”, but also the impression she left us.

We must become tools of transformation in the world and pursue our journey to the Kingdom. Each one, in his or her own measure, must live and spread the message of love the Lady of All Peoples left us, becoming in this way the “agents of expansion” of a vast movement which will end up by conquering the world.

In fact, Marie-Paule brought to the peoples the look or the eyes of God. Having placed her whole being in the service of His message, she left us words, texts, recordings, videos, as well as the memory of her presence, and all of it testifies to the openness she bore within her, the call she made to all through her gaze and her attitude.

Few people had the opportunity to come into contact with Marie-Paule even just once. For those of us who had that chance, we must remember that we cannot have been witnesses without being called upon to bear witness some day. We will not all do so in the same way; it will be personal for each one of us. But together, we will contribute to the “great action” the Lady of All Peoples spoke of in her messages. That action is ahead of us; when it will begin, that will be the sign of the start of the “great march” towards the building up of the Kingdom on earth.

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
