

# A NEW BREATH

## Supplementary Information

In the last issue of the review (no. 274, p. 4), under the title “A New Breath”, there was a short article in which were briefly presented the recent measures taken in the Lady’s Work, so as to be better able to respond to today’s demands and challenges. One of these was the setting up of a “Council” or “Committee” bringing together different persons to whom Heaven, through Marie-Paule, had attributed a well-defined responsibility, confirmed by the bestowal of a particular title.

The initiative for the setting up of this Council was Father Yvan Laprise’s. He had been appointed by Marie-Paule “Lieutenant General of the ‘Kingdom Mary Queen’” (*The White Book V*, p. 159), and she had charged him with seeing to the good general coordination of the works she would leave us upon her departure. It was after a particularly significant event last January that Father Yvan felt the time had come to act according to that mandate.

In fact, since Marie-Paule’s departure – and even before that, given the deterioration in her state of health – each one of the Directors had taken to heart to manage as best he could the field of action entrusted to him. However, it had become apparent over time that this was not always very simple: where did one’s responsibility end and that of the other person begin? And what about those areas in which not everything had been completely defined? Marie-Paule left behind many works, foundations, corporations, so that with time, certain difficulties had arisen which it was now necessary to look at together. All the elements of the Lady’s heritage also had to be brought together so that each one could have all the information at his disposal.



This was the reason why Father Yvan set up an “assembly of those in charge” (the names and titles are mentioned in the previous issue), a sort of “Action Committee” or of “General Council” which would deal with all the matters by always referring to Marie-Paule’s words and writings and the arrangements she had made. To this day, four meetings were held (February 2, February 22, March 8 and March 29) and the first task at the first meeting was, in fact, to clearly define the responsibilities of each one, an indispensable starting point for a fruitful cooperation for the benefit of the whole of the Lady’s Work.

Among the other topics dealt with, current events would first impose the one of Covid-19 with the restrictions ordered by the health authorities which evolved from week to week. There was also the revision of the Boards of Directors of the Work’s Corporations and the updating of different sets of book-keeping, the improvements required in certain buildings, the organization of future Days of Prayer, the next ceremony of Confirmation, the broadcasting of funeral Masses by Internet and the manner in which a good atmosphere of piety could be fostered in the funeral parlor at Virgo-Fidelis, the complete restructuring of the Internet websites of the Community of the Lady and of Radio Love which are no longer adapted to today’s needs, and so forth.

A lot of work has already been done, and much still remains to be done, but the impetus has been given with a view to preparing the Lady’s Work for its future action and thus enable it “to go forward in joy, peace and harmony”, according to the words of Father Victor, Marian Father.
